ISO is the International Organization for Standardization

- **ISO** develops Standards for use worldwide.
 - Many are product-based (types of coatings or hardware)
 - Some Standards are **Management System Requirements:**
 - Standards for Quality Systems, Environmental Systems, Safety Systems, Data Security Systems, etc.
 - ISO 9001:2015 is a global standard for a Quality Management System (QMS).

The **IAQG** is the International Aerospace Quality Group.

- Representatives come from aviation, space, and defense industries.
- The **AIAG's** Created the AS9100D Standard
- AS9100 = ISO 9001 + Some additional requirements for Aviation, Space, and Defense.

ISO, International Organization for Standardization, is a network of standards organizations that coordinates the development and maintenance, of management and other standards.

ISO develops a variety of standards for product features like film, fasteners, etc., as well as management systems to help operate an organization.

The ISO 9001 Quality Management System is the most popular quality management system in the world, and is the basis for AS9100.

The IAQG represents professionals from Aviation, Space & Defense companies throughout the world. They create the AS9100 standard, then members comment and vote on the standard before the document becomes a released standard.

- Quality (QMS)
- Environmental (EMS)
- Safety (SMS)
- Energy (EnMS)
- IT (MIS) etc.
